2016 CPHA WEST COAST PRE-GREEN PROGRAM

SPECIFICATIONS

Horses enrolled in the CPHA West Coast Pre-Green Program will be entitled to participate in Stake Classes throughout the year as well as the \$25,000 CPHA West Coast Pre-Green Championship. The 2016 Championship will take place at the Blenheim Fall Festival, September 14-18. In addition, fifty per cent of enrollment fees collected will be awarded as cash bonuses to the top three Riders and Horses based on points earned prior to the Championship and fifty per cent will be added back to the Finals prize money. Rider money will be awarded 1st – 30%, 2nd – 25% and 3rd – 10%. Leading Horse money will be awarded 1st – 20%, 2nd – 10% and 3rd – 5%.

Stake Classes can be run at USEF approved horse shows as one round part of the Pre-Green section, or as a two- round stand alone (class) or classic. CPHA Pre-Green classes can be run concurrently with other Pre-Green Stake Classes or Incentive Classes. If there is a pre-green class separate from the section that offers prize money (and the section does not) that class may be run concurrently with the CPHA pre green incentive program. The Championship Class will offer \$25,000 in prize money as well as 50% of enrollment fees. Horses will be allowed to compete in either height category at all shows, including the Championship. Horses must be enrolled in the CPHA West Coast Pre-Green Program in order to compete in the Stake Classes. All enrolled horses will be allowed to participate in the Championship even they have not competed in any CPHA pre green incentive class prior to the championships as long as they are registered with the CPHA.

The order of go for the Championship will be reverse order of points earned throughout the series.

The CPHA Pre-Green Program is open to all riders and open to all horses eligible to compete in the Pre-Green Section. Enrollment fees for the 2016 CPHA West Coast Pre-Green Program are \$250 prior to March 1, \$350 prior to July 1, \$425 prior to August 15 and \$500 prior to the Championship. Horses must be registered with the CPHA. Riders and owner of the horse must be CPHA members to be eligible for cash bonuses and points.

Points for Rider and Horse standings will be awarded for the stake classes through eight places as follows: 1st – 10, 2nd – 8, 3rd – 6, 4th – 5, 5th – 4, 6th – 3, 7th – 2, 8th – 1. In addition, one point will be added for each entry in the class. For example, a stake class with 14 entries will be pointed as follows: 1st – 24, 2nd – 22, 3rd – 20, 4th – 19, 5th – 18, 6th – 17, 7th – 16, 8th – 15.
